You will be working on your short comics graphics in a pair of writer/graphic artist with one person based in Germany/Europe and the other based in West Africa, so that you can profit from your different experiences.

Who can apply?

- You are between 16 and 25.
- You live in Germany or you are based on the African continent, preferably West Africa
- You have a stable internet connection
- You have good conversational skills in English

How to apply:

- Send us an example of your talent, either **a writing example** (a poem, a short story, a creative writing piece, no more than 500 words) or an **example of your art** (concept art, comic book art or illustration)
- Please submit a letter of motivation and mention which tools you work with. (no more than 1 page)
- We accept applications in French and German but the language of the workshop is English

What we offer:

- A 5-months digital writing and drawing workshop for 12 participants
- **Regular digital tutoring** with the group and two workshop facilitators, who are experienced professionals.
- Your short comic will enter the selection process for **a publication** and you will present it during a public event in Berlin.
- Depending on your needs, we provide **artistic and technical equipment** (for example: coloured pencils, brushes, drawing paper, sketch pads, pencils, charcoal, paints or watercolours and possibly tablets or appropriate software for digital graphic development).
- You will receive a 200 Euro (or the equivalent in your local currency) honorarium.
